### Statement

We approach precariousness with the assumption that work and life interpenetrate each other, which means they cannot be grasped with a traditional concept of work. Precariousness thus doesn't take place in the area of labor alone, but affects and concerns life as a whole. Our concern is to understand the conditions of subjectivity that are connected with it, such as gender relations, their history, and current transformations. Precariousness is thus not an occurrence now taking place for the first time just because the normal work relationships are changing. Rather, the term precariousness can apply to economic and social conditions that until this point have primarily affected women and migrants.
